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How to Register on the Project Website

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STEPS TO REGISTER

Go to the <u>CHANGE Environment Project Website</u> and locate the teacher registration form (at the end of the curriculum page).

Fill out the form with your details, and if you don't find your school listed, select "Other" under the school's name field and manually input your school's name.

Submit the registration.

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After you complete the registration, you will receive an email containing:

- A list of unique codes corresponding to the number of students you indicated in the registration form.
- Two evaluation links for pre- and postproject assessment.





Important Notes:

Student Codes:

Once you receive the list of student codes, assign a unique code to each student. It's important to keep track of which student receives which code. We recommend printing the list of codes and associating them with each student. This process ensures anonymity and protects student data.

Evaluation Process:

The first evaluation should be completed before beginning the implementation of the stages with students.

The second evaluation should be completed after finishing all stages of the project.

By registering, you're helping us measure the success and reach of the project and ensuring that we can continue improving the curriculum based on feedback and data.
